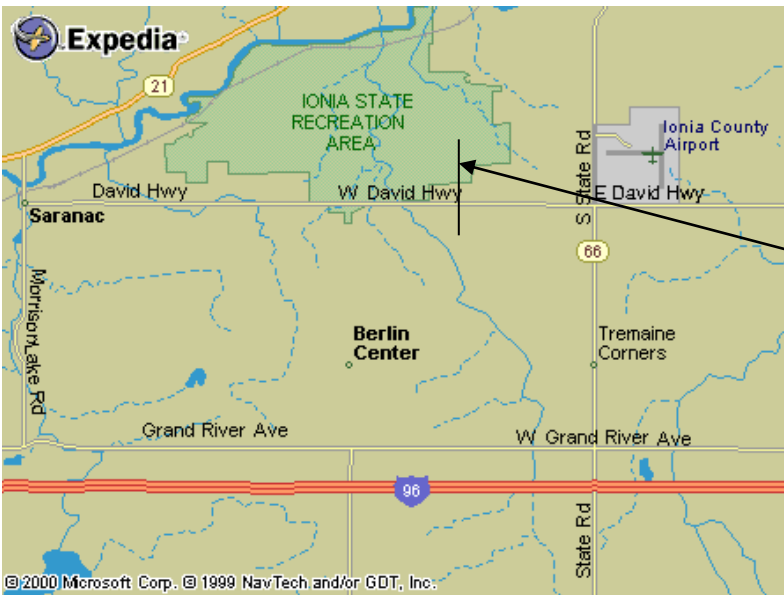
Directions to the Grounds

Field trial grounds are located within the Ionia State Rec. Area , between Ionia and Interstate 96 just west of State Route M66.

A Michigan Motor Vehicle State Permit is necessary to park on the grounds.
Permits may be purchased at the grounds.

Take M66 to David Highway-west to Harwood Rd. north (about a mile) to the trial grounds staging area/horse barn/activity center.

Course 2: Take M66 north to Riverview Dr. [bottom of the hill-yellow blinker] Turn LEFT onto Riverview Dr. Course 2 is way down on the LEFT behind the old schoolhouse. Bring water. Latrines only.



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
